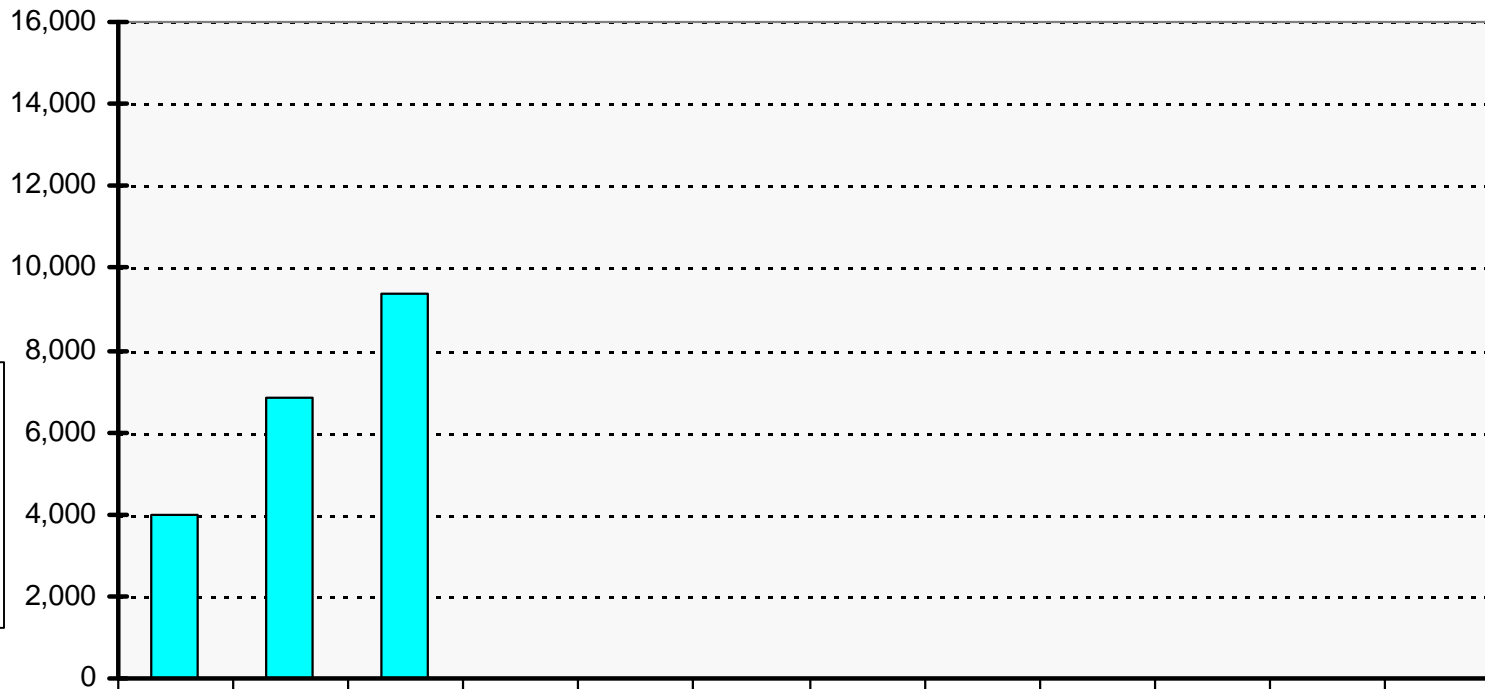

“**UNHCR Registrations**” is the only “hard figure” based on the registration process in municipalities and UNHCR Field Offices.

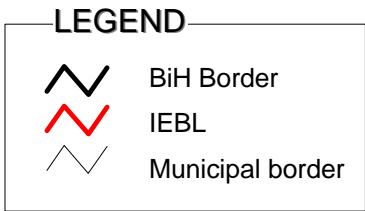
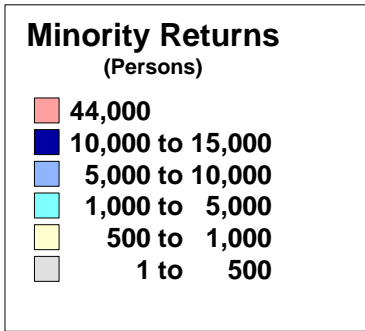
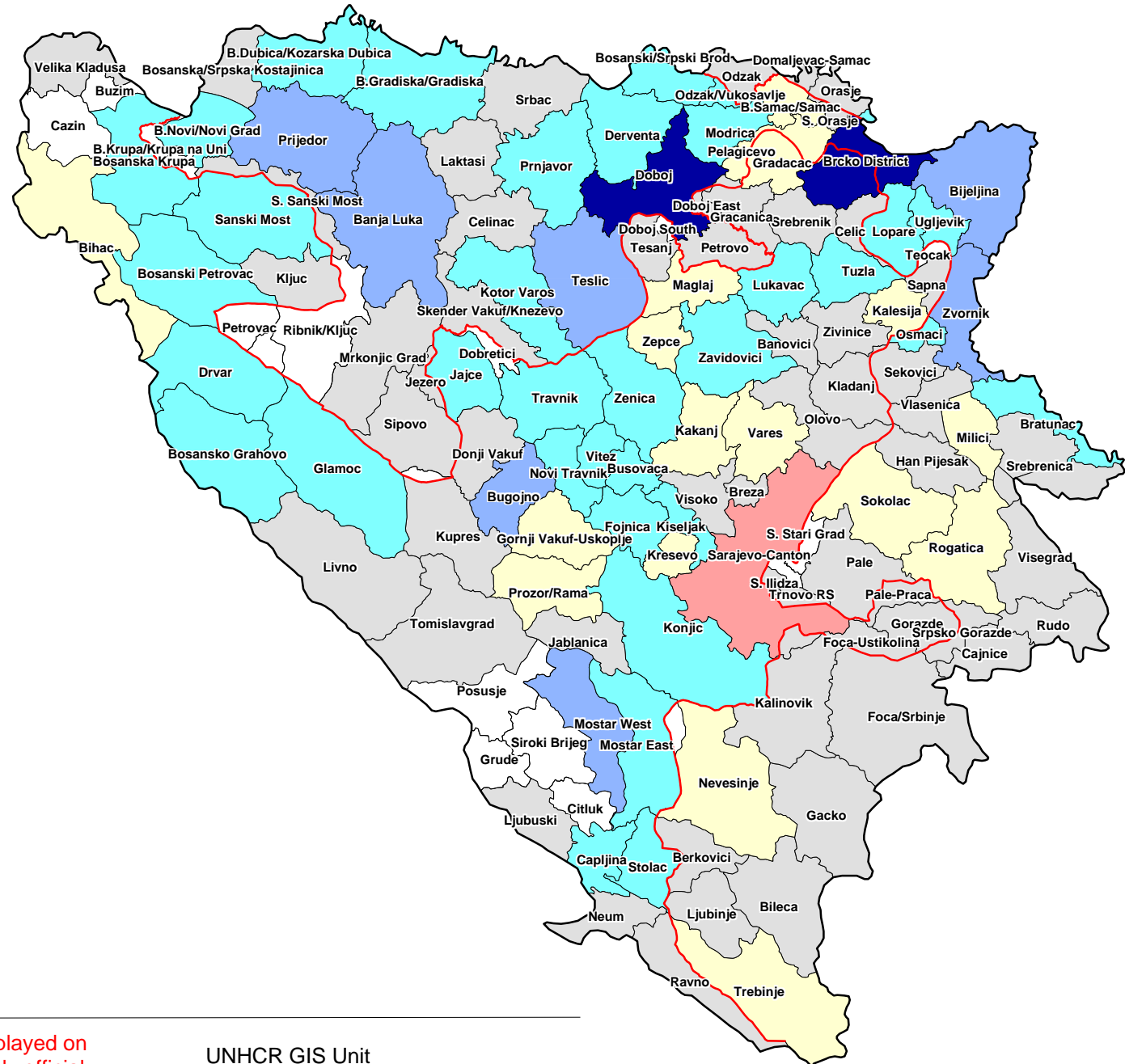
